

CAMP COUNSELORS NEEDED

The Texas State Historical Association and Fort McKavett State Historic Site are looking for dedicated, enthusiastic, experienced and energetic male and female counselors ages 18 and up.

The program, *Old Stories, New Voices Intercultural Youth Camp*, needs diverse counselors to assist with camp activities and to mentor participants, ages 9 to 12. The camp, held July 20-26, 2008, takes place at Fort McKavett, near Menard, Texas.

Qualified applicants **MUST** attend a training session, **(Thur.-Sat., July 17-19, 2008)** and work the entire week of camp, **Sunday, July 20-Saturday, 26, 2008.**

Counselors receive:

- Background Reading Materials and Orientation Training
- Transportation from regional meeting sites to Fort McKavett and back
- Lodging while at camp
- All meals, snacks, and supplies during camp
- A stipend of \$350

Counselors will also be afforded the opportunity to participate in future programs based on performance, including:

- Summer 2009, successful participants from 2008 will be invited back to Fort McKavett for a camp focused on post-Civil War military and frontier life.
- Summer 2010, top participants from 2009 will be invited to participate in a two-week cross-country bus tour from Glorieta Pass, New Mexico to Gettysburg, Pennsylvania focused on the American Civil War with participants from Colorado, Nebraska, and Pennsylvania.
